



German Language Course Visa as a preparation for university studies (§ 16b AufenthG)

If you intend to attend a long-term language course (for longer than 90 days) as a condition of admission for university studies in Germany, you are required to obtain a residence permit in the form of a visa. A language course visa as preparation for university studies can later be converted into a residence permit for study purposes after official admission by university.

General Information

- The application can be submitted at the earliest 6 months before the planned entry.
- The standard processing time is 2 weeks, in individual cases even longer.
- Documents that are not issued in German or English must be submitted together with a translation.
- The Consulate General reserves the right to request further documentation.

Checklist

Please submit the documents listed below in according order in original and one copy each.

Originals will be returned after examination.

Copies will not be made by Consulate General staff. Please do not staple the documents.

- Fully completed and signed [visa application form](#) (no copy required)
- [Declaration of genuineness of submitted documents](#) (no copy required)
- Passport, which is valid for at least six months, which was issued in the last ten years and with at least two free pages (copy of photo page and pages with visas, stamps, etc. required)
- Proof of residency in Hong Kong
 - Hong Kong stay permit and a Hong Kong Identity Card or
 - Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card (only applicable for non Hong Kong passport holders)
- Two passport photos according to [biometric specifications](#) (not older than 3 months)
- Confirmation letter from the language school with details (cost, level, length, etc.)
- Conditional admission/acceptance letter by a German university including a confirmation that a language course is a requirement
- Entitlement to university admission
(usually a high school diploma or graduation examination certificate)
- Evidence of previous academic performance (e.g. transcript record)
- Proof of German language knowledge
- Curriculum vitae
